



All trains will reduce speed to ten miles per hour over Missouri River bridge and trestles, and will not enter upon the bridge until signaled by bridge tender that bridge and draw spans are all right, and will reduce speed to ten miles per hour over South Creek Bridge No. 44, about two miles west of Allen.
